

# Disabling Java Automatic Updates for Windows

## Reasons for disabling:

- The Java updates could potentially contain a version that is not compatible with the current Singularity system
  - This can cause a loss of function within the system or other unforeseen consequences.

## Instructions on disabling the Java Automatic Updates:

1. If Java has already been started, you can right-click on the icon in the system tray and choose “Open Control Panel” like in Figure 1. Otherwise go to the Control Panel and double click on the Java icon.



Figure 1: Select the Java Control Panel

2. Click on the “Update” tab at the top of the Java Control Panel
3. Uncheck the checkbox for “Check for Updates Automatically” so that it resembles Figure 2.



Figure 2: Uncheck “Check for Updates Automatically”

- a. If a dialogue box appears asking you if you are sure you want to stop automatic updates, select “OK”
4. Click on the “OK” button on the bottom of the screen
